MUSIC PEDAGOGY - CHALLENGES, INSPIRATION AND CREATION

Symposium will be held in Cetinje from May 24 – 27, 2018.

At the symposium, we will be expecting papers dealing with topics related to both **general music pedagogy**, and **music schooling** at all education levels.

Applications along with abstracts up to 250 words and key words (up to 5) should be submitted by **February 10, 2018** to e-mail simped@ac.me. Application form is hereby attached, and it can also be found on the website of Music Academy http://www.ucg.ac.me/ma. All abstracts will be reviewed by members of the Programme Board. Notifications about accepted abstracts which will be printed in a bilingual publication of the *Book of Abstracts*, will be sent on **March 1, 2018**.

Timeframe for presentation is 20 minutes, while an additional 10 minutes slot is planned for a discussion. If the author opts for having the presentation in the form of a workshop, the planned time is 45 minutes.

Reviewed papers will be published in *Symposium Proceedings* which will be printed during 2018 and registered in international RILM pool (*Répertoire international de littérature musicale*).

Languages of the symposium are Montenegrin, Serbian, Croatian, Bosnian, and English.

Costs of travel and accommodation are covered by participants.

Symposium registration fee is 30 euros and it includes: programme of the symposium, Book of Abstracts, Symposium Proceedings, attendance at all sessions and formal dinner.
