### Personal Information and Education

Born on 17 November 1955 in Berane (Montenegro).

- He completed elementary school in Berane and High School in Podgorica with outstanding performance in 1974, and was awarded distinction diploma "Luca".
- In 1974/75, he enrolled at Faculty of Medicine at the University of Belgrade.
- He completed Faculty of Medicine at the University of Belgrade on 22 May 1980
- He began his specialization in the field of orthopedic surgery and traumatology at Faculty of Medicine at the University of Belgrade in January 1983, and completed his specialty exam with an outstanding grade on 6 October 1986.
- In 1992/93, he enrolled at postgraduate studies in the field of orthopedics with traumatology, which he completed with an outstanding performance, and defended a Master Thesis titled "Incidence of idiopathic scoliosis in Montenegro" in front of the panel of the Faculty of Medicine on 26 October 1998.
- He defended his PhD Thesis titled "Comparative analysis of operative and non-operative injuries of the distal tibiofibular syndesmosis" at the Faculty of Medicine University of Belgrade on 6 July 2000.

### Work and Academic Experience

- He started working at Clinical Center in Podgorica in January 1983, when he began his specialization in the field of orthopedic surgery and traumatology.
- Upon completion of the specialty exam, he works as orthopedic surgeon traumatologist at the Clinical Center of Montenegro.
- From 1992 to 1996 he was the Head of Pediatric Orthopedic Department, and from 1996 to 2000 he was the Head of Orthopedic and Traumatology Department.
- In November 2000, he was elected as the Director of the Clinic for Orthopedics and Traumatology of the Clinical Center of Montenegro, which he held until the end of 2009.
- He received the title of **Primarius** in May 1995.
- Scientific and Teaching Council of the University of Montenegro elected him as an **Assistant** at the Faculty of Medicine in Podgorica on 16 March 2001, teaching Surgery Orthopedics with Traumatology.
- Scientific and Teaching Council of the University of Montenegro elected him as **Docent** at the Faculty of Medicine in Podgorica on 31 March 2006, and was appointed as Assistant Professor on 7 July 2011.
