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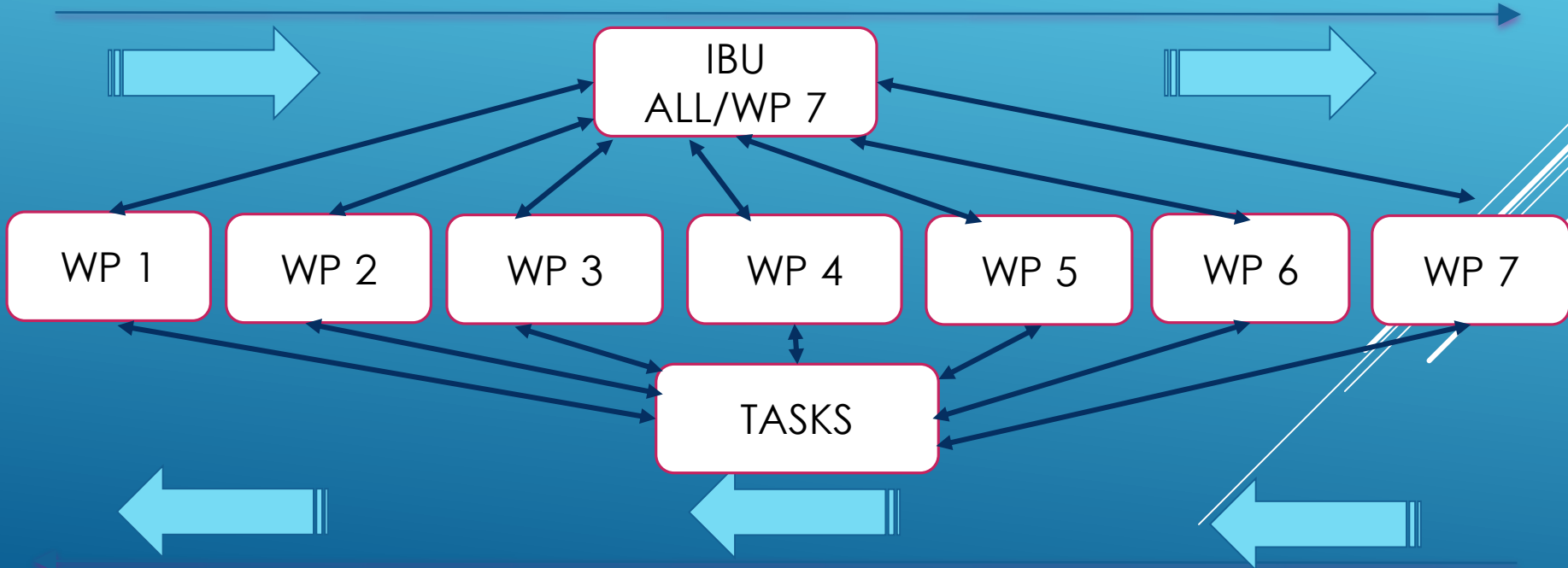
SUCCESS: GOALS OF THE PROJECT

Based on that, 4 courses within those study programmes will be updated. Modernisation of study programmes will also include introducing of entrepreneurship course at those 3 study programme.

- To create wide university-enterprise network in the Region as well as to set up innovative cooperation platform for the sharing of good practice between academia and business environment.

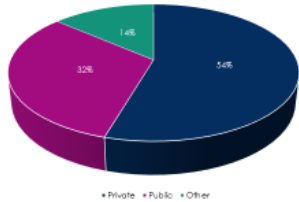

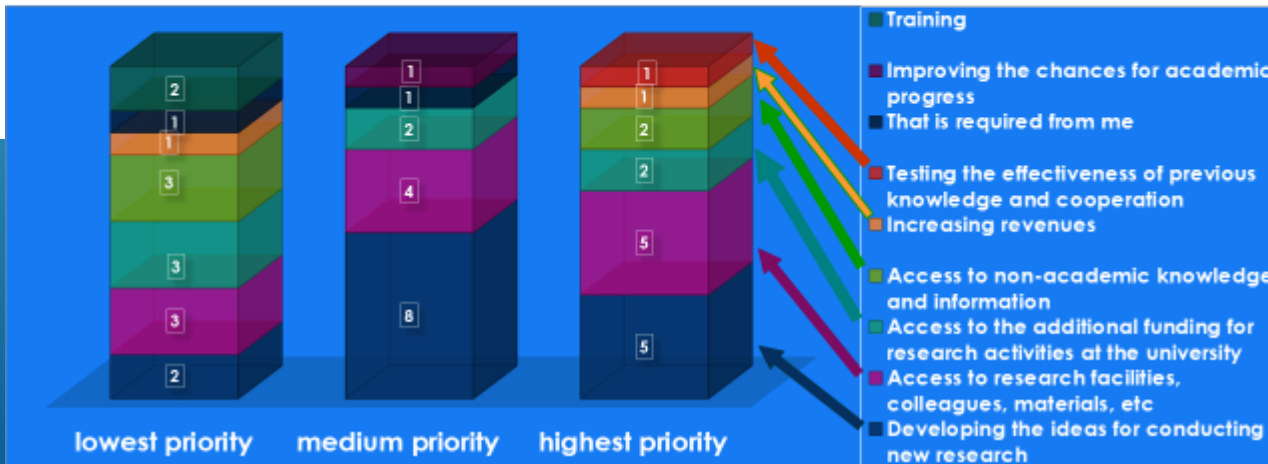

SUCCESS: WP1 – MONTENEGRO (SURVEY CONCLUSIONS)

Survey conclusions - recommendations.

- Increased knowledge and understanding on differences in operation of businesses and common points of cooperation.
- Improve scientific and technical cooperation by participating in joint projects.
- Increased application of international standards and thus adapting their teaching at the University.
- More active interaction - exchange of knowledge, information and experiences, training of new staff, development and standardization of new products.
- Increased development and application of dual education, practice as a crucial factor in development; better link between business needs and curriculum, including practice.
- Formalization of cooperation: e.g. use the formal agreements for mutual cooperation and defining points of interest for collaboration.
- Need for setting the clear legal framework for engaging academic staff in businesses and vice versa.
- Increasing the understanding of the benefits of univ.-businn. partnership.

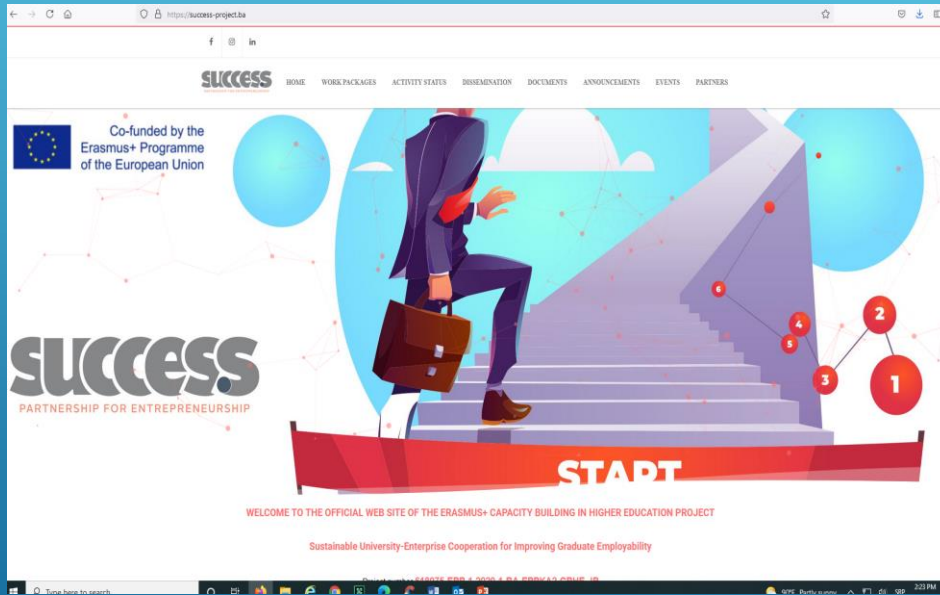
