

BIOGRAFIJA (Sanja Peković)

Dr Sanja Peković doktorirala je ekonomske nauke na Univerzitetu Paris-Est sa tezom "Motivi i efekti standarda kvaliteta i zaštite životne sredine: Mikro-ekonometrijska analiza", 2010. godine.

U periodu od 2006. do 2010. godine, bila je istraživač u Centre d'Etudes De l'Emploi i saradnik na Univerzitetu Paris-Est. Godine 2012. izabrana je za docenta na Univerzitetu Crne Gore, Fakultet za turizam i hotelijerstvo. Od 2018. je vanredni profesor na Univerzitetu Crne Gore. Njeni istraživački interesi su u oblasti menadžmenta kvaliteta, ekološke ekonomije, društvene odgovornosti, ekonomije inovacija i ekonometrije.



Dr Peković je bila gostujući istraživač na INRA-SupArgo (Montpellier), u Laboratoriji CNRS UMI 2615 Francusko-Russe Poncelet (Moskva), na Institutu za zaštitu životne sredine, UCLA (Los Angeles), Univerzitet Cote d'Azur, Nica, Univerzitet Varna, Bugarska, itd.

Objavila je oko 25 radova u vodećim časopisima sa SCI/SCIE/SSCI lista u oblasti ekonomije i menadžmenta (npr. *Creativity and Innovation*, *International Journal of Production Economics*, *Business & Society*, *Long Range Planning*, *Journal of Organizational Behaviour*, *Environmental and Resource Economics*, *Resource and Energy Economics*, *Technovation*, itd.), kao i značajan broj radova u drugim časopisima i monografijama izdatim od strane renomiranih izdavača.

Dr. Peković je bila predavač na brojnim domaćim i međunarodnim konferencijama, simpozijumima i naučnim skupovima.

Pored toga, dr Peković je i potpredsednik / predsjednik nekoliko renomiranih konferencija, kao i recenzent za nekoliko prestižnih časopisa, kao i aktivan član nekoliko akademskih mreža i društava. Saradnik je i konsultant na brojnim projektima koji se finansiraju od strane domaćih i međunarodnih organizacija (npr. ERASMUS +, Heric, IPA, COST, itd.).

Od 2017. godine je direktor Centar za unapređenje kvaliteta Univerziteta Crne Gore. Potpredsjednik je Upravnog odbora Naučno – tehnološki parka. Takođe je član Senata Univerziteta Crne Gore.

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
