



### Who is DAAD?


### The DAAD is ...







### Scholarships 2024/2025



### **Study Scholarships – Master Studies for All Academic Disciplines**

- Graduates of all disciplines (BA)
- 10 24 months, depending on the programme
- Start: 1st of October, 2024
- Requirements:
  - University degree (BA), latest in summer 2024
  - Admission to German university at the **beginning** of the scholarship
- 934,- € per month, travel allowance, insurance, (additional benefits)
- **460,-** € one-off study allowance for Montenegro



Application deadline: **15.11.2023** 



### **Master Studies - Two way application procedure**

### Applying for a **scholarship**

15.11.23: Application deadline

→ via DAAD-Portal (applicants have to submit at least 3 profiles of the chosen MA programmes)

02/2024: Interviews (online)

**04/2024:** Announcement of the results /

Letter of award

### Applying at universities

**03-07/2024:** Application periods at universities start

**05-08/2024:** Letter of Admission from the universities

Receiving a DAAD Scholarship, doesn't mean to get admission at university!

### **Special subjects - Master's programmes**

- Study Scholarships Postgraduate Studies in the Field of Architecture
- → application deadline: **25.09.2023**
- Study Scholarships Postgraduate Studies in the Field of Music
- → application deadline: **28.09.2023**
- Study Scholarships -Postgraduate Studies in the Field of the Performing Arts
- → application deadline: **02.11.2023**
- Study Scholarships Postgraduate Studies in the Fields of Fine Art, Design,
  Visual Communication and Film
- → application deadline: **30.11.2023**



### **Doctoral Candidates**

- Doctoral Programmes in Germany (<u>individual</u> or <u>structured</u>, up to 4 years)
- One-year-grants (7-12 months) or short term grants (1-6 months)
- Bi-nationally Supervised Doctoral Degrees / Cotutelle (total maximum of 2 years)
- 934,- € per month for graduates not taking doctoral degree
  1300,- € for doctoral candidates,
  travel allowance, insurance, (additional benefits)
- Application deadline: 15.11.2023
  (short term: 15.11.2023 + 30.04.2024)





### **Research Stays**

- For university academics and scientists
- 1-3 months
- 2000,- € assistant teachers, assistant professors, lecturers
  - **2150,-** € professors Travel allowance
- Application Deadlines:
  15.11.2023 (June to November)
- 30.04.2024 (December to May)

### **University Summer Language Courses in Germany (HSK)**

- Students of all disciplines (BA, MA, PhD)
- 3-4 weeks at a German university
- Between June and September
- Requirements:
  - 2 years completed at university
  - Basic knowledge of German (A2, PhDs A1)
  - Students have to be enrolled at a Montenegrin university during the course
- **1134,-** €, travel allowance (**525,-** €), insurance
- Application deadline: 01.12.2023



### **DAAD Project Funding**

### **Study trips to Germany**

- Study visits / study seminares and internships in Germany, headed by an university teacher
- 7-12 days
- 10-15 participants
- Flat-rate sum of 50,- € per person and day
- Deadlines:
- 01.11. each year → start: 01.03.
- 01.02. each year → start: 01.06.
- 01.05. each year  $\rightarrow$  start: 01.09.





### How to apply successfully?



### Facts and hints for a successfull application

- Register at DAAD portal
- Plan your application carefully, start now!
- Ask a professor for a reference (→ form on DAAD portal)
- PhD get in contact with German university as early as possible
- The core is the motivation letter!
  - Facts about your education, skills and knowledge
  - Academic motivation
  - Reasons for applying for a scholarship
- Application deadline: 15.11.2021
