

DAAD

University Summer Courses in Germany

- How long? 3-4 weeks at German Universities
- Who? Students of all disciplines (BA, MA, PhD)
- Requirements: minimum language level of A2 for doctoral students: minimum language level of A1
- 2 years completed at university
- Value: 950 €, travel allowence, Payments towards health, accident and personal liability insurance cover
- Application Deadline: 01.12.2018

IMPORTANT: Students have to be enrolled at a Montenegrin University during the course!

Study Scholarships for Graduates of ALL Disciplines

- Target group: Graduates (BA) of all disciplines (except arts, architecture)
- Requirements:

DAAL

- University degree (BA), very good gpa
- English degree program: very good knowledge of English
- German degree program: good knowledge of German
- Admission to German university at the **beginning** of the scholarship
- Hint: Motivation Letter is very important!
- 10-24 months, depending on programme; start: 1 Oct 2019
- Value: Scholarship payments of 850 € a month, Payments towards health, accident and personal liability insurance cover, Travel allowance, One-off study allowance, Language course in preparation

Application Deadline: 15.11.2018



Study Scholarships for Foreign Graduates

in the Field of Architecture

Application Deadline: 30.09.2019

in the Field of Music, Performing Arts, in the Fields of Fine Art, Design, Visual Communication and Film

Application Deadlines:

15.10.2018 (Music) 31.10.2018 (Performing Arts) 30.11.2018 (Fine Art, Designs,...)

A Portfolio has to be submitted to the DAAD in Bonn!

Beginning of Feb 2019: Interviews in Belgrade

04/2019: Announcement of the results / Letter of award



Research Grants

- Who can apply? Excellently-qualified young academics and scientists who have completed a Master's degree or Diploma
- **Types:**

DAAL

- Doctoral Programmes in Germany (structured or individual up to 4 years)
- 1 year grants (7-10 months) or short term grants (1-6 months)
- Bi-nationally Supervised Doctoral Degrees (max. 2 years)
- Cotutelle Doctoral Programmes (18 months within 3 years)
- Value: Depending on academic level, monthly payments of: 850 € for graduates, 1.200 € for doctoral candidates

Payments towards health, accident and personal liability insurance cover, Travel allowance, Language course

Application Deadline: 15.11.2018

Application Deadline short term: 15.11.2018 & 30.04.2019




Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists

- Who can apply? University teachers and established academics and scientists who have usually completed a doctoral degree and work at a university or research institute in their home country.
- Duration: 1- 3 month
- Value: Monthly payments of
 2.000 € for assistant teachers, assistant professors and lecturers,
 2.150 € for professors

Study Visits for Academics - Artists and Architects

- The aim of this programme is to promote artistic cooperations with German host institutions.
- Who can apply? University teachers from the following disciplines: Architecture, Fine Art, Film, Design/Visual Communication, Performing Arts, Music
- Duration: 1-3 months

DAAU

 Value: Monthly payments of 2,000 euros for assistant teachers, assistant professors and lecturers, 2,150 euros for professors Travel allowance



Important Facts:

- Application Deadline (master and research): 15.11.2018
- Musicians: 15.10.18, Perfoming Arts: 31.10.18, Designer etc: 31.11.18
- Language Summer Schools: 01.12.2018
- No age limit

Application only possible via DAAD-Portal (online)



Hints for a successful application

- ✓ Plan your application thoroughly! Don't start too late!
- ✓ Ask your professor for a personal reference in time!
- ✓ Motivation letter Be clear about your reasons and goals!
 - facts about your education, skills and knowledge
 - academic motivation
 - reasons for applying for a scholarship
- PhD Get in contact with German university as early as possible!
- Be sure your application is complete!
- Don't use staples or other metallic items!
- ✓ All documents have to be submitted online and handed in at the German




