**FOR EU CITIZENS** 

Students, who are citizens of the EU, can enter Montenegro with a valid passport. Within 24 hours after arrival, they must register their stay at the Tourist Organisation in the city of stay. After registration, students are obliged to start the procedure for obtaining a temporary stay permit at the Ministry of Interior Affairs.

**FOR NON-EU CITIZENS** 

Students, who are nationals of NON-EU countries, are obliged to obtain a visa in their home country or the nearest neighboring country where there is an Embassy of Montenegro before their departure to Montenegro.

Upon their arrival in Montenegro, students must register in the Tourist Organisation within the 24 hours. After registration, they must start the procedure for obtaining residence permit for a temporary stay.
