



02 THE UNIVERSITY OF MONTENEGRO

The University of Montenegro is the oldest and largest higher education, scientific and artistic institution in Montenegro.

The University of Montenegro was founded on April 2nd, 1974, in Podgorica. On that day representatives of three faculties – the Faculty of Economics, the Technical Faculty and the Faculty of Law, as well as two colleges – the Pedagogical Academy in Nikšić and the Maritime College in Kotor, and three institutes – the Historical Institute, the Agriculture Institute and the Institute for Biological and Medical Research in Titograd, adopted an Association Agreement, becoming one institution. The University Day is celebrated on April 29th.

Today, the University is comprised of 19 faculties and 4 scientific institutes. The headquarters and main campus of the University is in Podgorica, with other campuses located in other Montenegrin towns – Nikšić, Cetinje, Kotor, Igalo, Bar, Bijelo Polje and Berane.

The values of the University of Montenegro lie in academic excellence, autonomy, creativity, and the freedom to create, as well as in support for teachers, researchers and students in an effort to raise their profile among the national and international public in areas relevant to their profession.

The University of Montenegro is an integrated public university, organized according to the principles of the Bologna Declaration, with curricula harmonized with those at the most respected European universities. This, as well as the numerous agreements and programmes in which the University takes part, enables mobility without barriers across the European Higher Education Area for students, teachers and administrative staff. The University of Montenegro has signed 137 bilateral cooperation agreements with universities from 39 countries around the world.

Organization of Studies

Studies at the University of Montenegro are organized at the level of Undergraduate, Masters and Doctoral studies. The basic model of study is 3+2+3 meaning that Undergraduate studies last three academic years, except for specific regulated professions; post-graduate (Masters) studies last two years and Doctoral studies take three academic

years to complete. The University is continuously engaged in the restructuring and modernising of all its study programmes and their harmonisation with modern trends and the needs of the labour market. Amongst other things, obligatory practical work has been introduced for most study programmes, and courses of English are obligatory.

The Centre for Quality Assurance

The Centre for Quality Assurance is part of the organizational structure of the Rectorate and is responsible for the functioning of the quality assurance system at the University of Montenegro. It was established with the aim of building institutional mechanisms for maintaining and improving the quality of various aspects of the university's operations—study programs, processes and procedures, teaching and research—while fostering and expanding a culture of quality.

The Board for Quality Assurance and the Board for Monitoring of Master Studies are permanent expert bodies within the Centre.

To maintain the quality assurance framework, the Centre is tasked with producing relevant documentation, as well as drafting and implementing quality standards and procedures. It leads the self-evaluation process to assess and improve quality practices across the University. In addition, the Centre provides expert support to the Senate, assisting in decision-making related to quality matters. It also reviews accreditation reports for study programs to ensure they meet established standards.

Furthermore, the Centre focuses on offering expert and methodological support to University staff in developing and overseeing quality system procedures. This includes regular training on quality assurance standards, procedures, and key performance indicators, ensuring that all university stakeholders are well-equipped to meet the highest quality standards in their work.

The Centre for Doctoral Studies

The Centre for Doctoral Studies is responsible for the continuous improvement of the quality of PhD studies within the Doctoral School of the University of Montenegro and of the international recognition of the University within the European Research Area and the European Higher Education Area. The Centre encourages multidisciplinary approaches to Doctoral studies and their connection to society at large. The Centre, among other tasks, defines the fields of PhD studies, organises teaching, and approves curricula and the engagement of teachers in PhD studies. It encourages, organises and implements research ventures of a multidisciplinary nature and performs other activities within the area of PhD studies.

The professional body at the Centre is the Board for Doctoral Studies, which manages PhD studies and is responsible for the procedures of the self-evaluation, continuous monitoring and quality improvement of Doctoral study programmes.

The Communication and PR Centre

The Communication and PR Centre engages in communication activities at the University level both with the public and the media, in cooperation with the other organizational units of the University.

The Centre performs internal and external PR activities and creates strategic activities related to public relations. The Centre is responsible for monitoring and informing the media, as well as for communication between the University and the public. Additionally, the Centre organizes various events at the University and prepares the promotional material necessary for the successful processes of internal and external communication at the University. The main priority of the Centre is the promotion of scientific research and artistic work, the presentation of outstanding students, teachers and researchers and their results and cooperation with the media – in short taking a proactive approach to issues pertaining to the University of Montenegro in the public realm.



The Centre for International Cooperation and Career Development

Centre for International Cooperation and Career Development is in charge of the overall inter-university and international cooperation, as well as the internationalization process of the University of Montenegro.

It includes the following offices:

- International Relations and Mobility Office
- The Projects Office
- The Office for Career Development and Lifelong Learning
- Francophone Employment Office

International Relations and Mobility Office is in charge of the overall international cooperation of the University of Montenegro. It also provides support to students and teaching staff interested in applying for international mobility programs, as well as to students and lecturers coming to the University of Montenegro from abroad.

The Office organizes information days, seminars, workshops and presentations on mobility programmes and on how to apply for scholarships. Through mobility programmes, students of the University of Montenegro have the opportunity to spend from three to twelve months during their studies at another higher education institution, at all study levels. Staff can apply for teaching or training mobility.

The Project Office serves as institutional focal point for project initiation, support for project implementation, overall project and financial management. The Office institutes key information and practices related to University portfolio and project management, by providing expertise, advice and technical support to University of Montenegro organizational units.

The Office for Career Development and Lifelong Learning is a support service to college and high school students, as well as those who are interested in lifelong learning programmes. It supports high school students in choosing their future vocation, preparing them for the academic environment, as well as preparing students for the labour market. It is also focused on connecting them with the business sector, regarding the implementation of professional practices and potential work engagements.

This Office organizes various trainings and workshops, as well as events for development of practical skills and entrepreneurial awareness. Among them are: Internship and scholarship fair, Open day of the University of Montenegro, Seasonal employment fair – Summer Job, Training for beginners in business, Competition for the best student start-up idea, Educational program *Student business hub*, Workshops *Presentation skills to the employer*, career guidance and counselling sessions.

The Francophone Employment Office of the University of Montenegro (CEF Montenegro) is aimed at contributing to improvement of employability and professional integration of Montenegrin students, as well as developing entrepreneurial lifestyle and strengthening professional competences for the 21st century. The office organizes a large number of professional certifications and complementary educations, as university services complementary to existing academic and administrative structure.

The Central University Library

The Central University Library represents the central library of the University of Montenegro, it is of general scientific and open type, which acts as a support to scientific and educational, and scientific and research processes at the University and in country.

The Library is in charge for the organization and development of the whole library information system of the University, and at the same time it is the main library for all specialized libraries within the University.

Users of the Library are students, teachers, teaching assistants, scientists and researchers, but also all other interested users who find its services needed. Membership is free of charge, and library funds could be used in reading rooms of the Library or could be borrowed for a specific period of time.

Apart from the funds of monographies and series publications (books, teaching books, collection of papers, magazines, journals, and other forms of publications), the Library owns the collection of PhD and Master thesis defended at the University of Montenegro, collection of reference publications and two legacies.

The Central University Library is a depository library for publications of the University of Montenegro, papers published by teachers and associates, as well as PhD and Master Thesis defended at the University of Montenegro.

Funds and collections of the Library could be searched through the online catalogue at the address cg.cobiss.net. Within the COBISS system, the Library develops personal bibliographies of researchers from the University of Montenegro, and each member of the academic community are obliged to submit their work to the Library. Bibliographies of researchers are available at the address cg.cobiss.net, which enables following of research activities at the University, both at personal and general – institutional level.

Digital archive of the University of Montenegro – PHAIDRA (Permanent Hosting, Archiving and Indexing of Digital Resources and Assets) represents a system for permanent archiving, keeping, indexing and using of all types of digital documents and objects which are created through teaching, scientific and research activities at the University. The integral part of the digital repository, titled *E-thesis of the University of Montenegro*, is the subsystem of doctoral thesis defended at the University.

The Centre of Information Systems

The Centre of Information Systems (CIS) is the core of the University of Montenegro academic network and one of the largest WAN networks in Montenegro. The Centre is constantly working on the improvement, further development and maintenance of the academic network infrastructure.

The CIS is devoted to the implementation of new services for over 20000 users, including the administration of the University, students, teaching staff, researchers and the state institutions connected to the academic network. The Centre for Information Systems is responsible for the management and monitoring of the Montenegrin Research and Educational Network (MREN). As entrusted by the Government of Montenegro, from April 2016, the Centre is responsible for management of the MIXP – the national exchange point in internet traffic in Montenegro. MIXP represents a tool for improving the quality of Internet access, the reduction of prices, the disburdening of links for global access and secure communication with regard to personal data protection and network security.

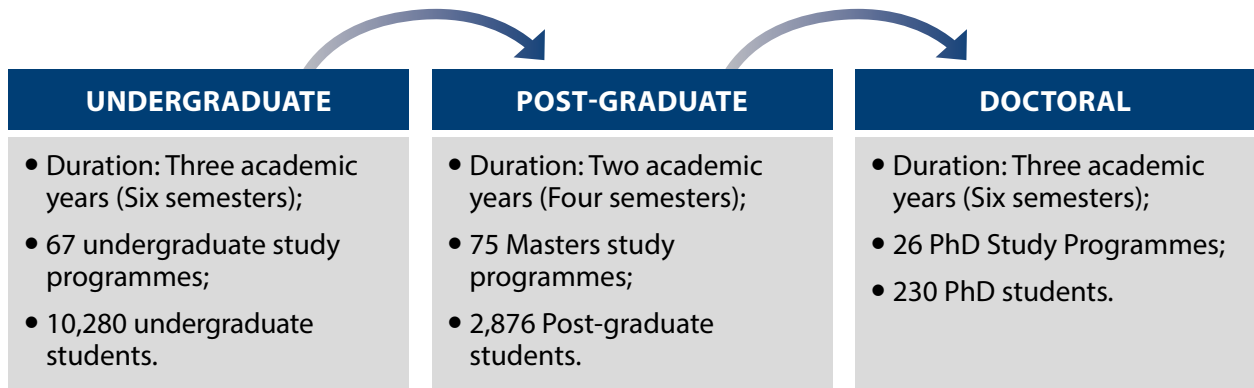

THE FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE

In its short history, the Faculty of Architecture has become a very recognizable part of the University of Montenegro. For almost two decades, it has provided education for a new generation of architects in accordance with the principles of the European Higher Education Area.

This national school of architecture in Podgorica is gradually growing into a European school that

has and follows the principles of the Manifesto of the leading European schools.

The Faculty is an independent university unit with an integrated study programme, following the model 5 + 0. In the fifth year of academic studies it provides the following elective modules:

- Integrated Architectural Design;
- Integrated Urban Design.





THE BIOTECHNICAL FACULTY

The Biotechnical Faculty is the oldest scientific research institution in Montenegro. It educates young people and experts to be able to aid the development of agriculture, as a strategic priority for Montenegro, in accordance with contemporary European trends.

The Faculty possesses an experimental field, Lješkolje, which is an expert research base for the development of all areas of agriculture.

It has 35 hectares of vineyards, an orchard, and greenhouses with field and vegetable crops. The Faculty has one of the richest collections of vines in the Balkans (with 442 genotypes).

18 THE FACULTY OF MARITIME STUDIES KOTOR

The Faculty of Maritime Studies Kotor is a modern higher education institution founded in 1959. In accordance with international standards (STCW Convention) and the recommendations of the International Maritime Organization, it educates and trains mariners and land-based maritime professionals.

It is focused not only on theoretical but also practical teaching, which enables students to work both in Montenegro and in the international maritime labour market.

The Faculty offers navigation, marine engineering, off-shore, GMDSS simulators, a lifeboat, laboratories, classical and computer classrooms and a modern amphitheatre. Within the Faculty there is a Centre for Research, Innovation and Entrepreneurship and the Training Centre for Seafarers.

Since 2000, the Faculty has been intensively coordinating work with the requirements of the quality system according to the standards of the World International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

Located in the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the old Montenegrin town of Kotor, based on the foundations of the Grammar School dating to the 13th century, the Faculty of Tourism and Hotel Management provides the opportunity for students to both study and *live* tourism.

The Faculty focuses on collaboration with companies, providing practice for students. It engages in intensive cooperation with international educational and scientific institutions.

The Faculty organizes professional training sessions, and implements scientific research and professional work in its field of expertise. It is an affiliate member of the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) and a member of the International Association supporting hospitality and tourism education and training (EURHODIP).

THE HISTORICAL INSTITUTE OF MONTENEGRO

The Historical Institute of the University of Montenegro, established in 1948, is the oldest scientific institution in the country, with a rich tradition in scientific research and expertise in historiography, Oriental studies, diplomacy, cultural heritage, media studies, and geopolitics. Our Institute is supported by a vast library and archival collections, recognized research methodologies, and an extensive publication record. With these capacities, we believe the Institute can serve as a valuable and relevant partner for collaborative projects in North Macedonia and Turkey.

The Institute deals with research on topics related to Montenegrin and general history. It publishes studies, monographs, paper collections, thematic collections of documents and bibliographies and the scientific journal *Historical Records*. The Institute also deals with the training of scientific personnel.

Taking into consideration the time of its creation, the Library of the Historical Institute of Montenegro is one of the oldest, and, by the content of the collection that contains old and rare books, it can be regarded as one of the most valuable Montenegrin libraries. It has the character of a scientific and the status of a

special library; it houses 40,000 books, 192 newspaper titles and 687 journals, making a total of 70,000 book units. Although the Library is of a closed type, its services, available to scientists working at the Historical Institute of Montenegro and their associates, can also be used by cultural and public workers and students. The Journal *Historical Records* continues the tradition of the oldest scientific journal in Montenegro called *Zapisi*, established in 1927. The journal is included in two international databases CEEOL (Central Eastern European Library) and EBSCO (Historical abstracts with full text).

The Institute has established itself as a reputable scientific institution in the fields of research, the organization of scientific meetings, conferences, round table and panel discussions and in its cooperation with scientific institutions and scientists both in the country and abroad.

It is a signatory of a high number of international agreements regarding scientific and research projects with relevant institutions from Serbia, Russia, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Italy, Poland, Slovenia and Ukraine.





30 THE INSTITUTE OF MARINE BIOLOGY

The Institute of Marine Biology was founded in 1961 with a Decree of the People's Republic of Montenegro and is one of the founders of the University of Montenegro. In 2004 Institute joined the University of Montenegro, whose member it remains to this day.

The internal organization of the Institute is divided into 5 scientific-research laboratories and one Centre: Laboratory for general biology and sea protection, Laboratory for mariculture and developmental research, Laboratory for ichthyology and marine fisheries, Laboratory for plankton and water quality, Laboratory for chemistry, biochemistry and oceanography and Centre for Adriatic Biodiversity Protection – Aquarium Boka, the only public aquarium in Montenegro, which is open for public since 2021.

Core competencies of the Institute lies in the comprehensive research of the marine and coastal area, which has its wide impact to the protection of marine and coastal environment. Besides the

fundamental research, the Institute is involved in many projects of a more practical nature, including marine fisheries, aquaculture, marine pollution, integrated coastal zone management, through which scientific research is put to practical use. Institute has strong international cooperation network in the Mediterranean area which is reflected in working on joint research projects, organization of conferences, summer schools, participation in international working groups, commissions and bodies dealing with scientific investigation, scientific recommendations and marine resource protection.

Although the Institute is not involved in the teaching process, field and laboratory classes are organized regularly for students from numerous Faculties in the region (Belgrade, Kragujevac, Novi Sad, Banja Luka), while research and preparation of master's and doctoral theses are carried out within the framework of numerous national and international projects. Since 1965, the Institute publishes scientific journal "Studia Marina".

THE INSTITUTE FOR INTERDISCIPLINARY AND MULTIDISCIPLINARY STUDIES

Institute for Interdisciplinary and Multidisciplinary Studies is founded as a special organisation unit of the University of Montenegro in July 2024. It is seated in Podgorica.

Activities of the Institute are as follows:

- Implementation of undergraduate, master and doctoral interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary study programs;
- Performance of science and research work, in accordance with the Law;
- Organisation of teaching and lifelong learning program implementation and issuing certificates for these programs;
- Development and implementation of international and national projects;
- Design and development of professional elaboration thesis, analyses and studies;
- Providing consulting, or expertise services and professional assistance in transfer of technologies by academic community towards business environment;

THE INSTITUTE FOR ADVANCED STUDIES

The Institute for Advanced Studies (INS) was founded as a scientific-research institution that aimed at contributing to development of multidisciplinary basic, applied and developmental research in priority scientific areas, especially in segment of:

- social and humanistic sciences (international relations, political science, social policy, public opinion polling, gender equality, public policy research, economics, law, sociology, anthropology, media and communications, history and archaeology, philosophy, ethics and religion, and others),
- information and communication technologies (multimedia technologies, software engineering, data processing, systems and architectures, information systems design, signal processing algorithms, computer vision, cryptography, cyber security, watermarking, artificial intelligence, machine learning, and others),
- biomedicine (basic research into the molecular basis and mechanisms of disease – cell and molecular biology, cancer biology, biochemis-

- Joint participation on the market with other units dealing with transfer of competence and technologies;
- Organizing conferences, seminars and other events dedicated to research and innovations;

try, new technologies in diagnosis and disease monitoring, personalized medicine, genetics and epigenetics, physiology and pharmacology, neuroscience, and others).

INS aims to increase the productivity of research teams, stimulate cooperation with international research institutions, stimulate cooperation with the economic sector in the segment of market-oriented research (especially using the financing model through the commercialization of scientific results) and the public sector in the segment of creating public policies based on facts (especially through cooperation with professional associations, non-governmental organizations and business entities), as well as coordinated management of research resources for joint use of research potential at the university level.

Focus of activities of the Institute for Advanced Studies is to intensify participation in scientific research projects financed by external (international) research funds, which meet high European and world scientific criteria.

STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE ORGANISATIONS

Each student organisation offers different fields of opportunity for students, depending on their programme orientation. The umbrella Student Organisation is the Student Parliament of the University of Montenegro, in addition to which there

are other organisations that bring together students of the University with similar interests. All of them have a desire to improve their knowledge, and share their experience with students both in the country and abroad.

The Student Parliament of the University of Montenegro

The Student Parliament of the University of Montenegro is an institutional representative student body. Since its establishment on 31st May 2004, the Student Parliament has been continuously working on the improvement of the conditions of student life and strengthening the student population in Montenegro. With representatives attached to the Steering Committee, the Senate, the Court of Honour, the Quality Assurance Board of the University of Montenegro and the Council for Higher Education, the Student Parliament participates in the decision-making process on behalf of students, with at least 20 percent participation in each decision making body at the University.

The Student Parliament's mission is to make students' voices heard and ensure that their interests are respected. That is why it encourages student activism, and the inclusion of students in social processes, for which the support of the whole of society is needed.

Since May 2016, the Student Parliament of the University of Montenegro has been a full member of European Student Union (ESU) – the umbrella organisation of National Student Unions from the whole of Europe, which has shifted its activities to the international level.





THE UNIVERSITY SPORTS AND CULTURAL CENTRE

The University Sports and Cultural Centre was opened on November 17th 2015, at a ceremony marking International Student Day.

The Centre has a sports centre, which covers over 5,400 m² and has about 800 seats in its stands. In the hall, apart from training, student leagues in team sports are also organised, and students can use the hall through the Student Sports Associations which are registered at individual University units. Given that the hall offers suitable facilities, matches of a national and international character are also held there. The Centre has accompanying facilities for various sports, six locker rooms, and sports equipment in accordance with international standards.

The Multimedia Hall of the Centre, with a capacity of 220 seats and technical services, serves as the cultural information centre of the University of Montenegro. Since it is one of the biggest halls in the city, it provides the opportunity to organise a wide range of events. The hall is equipped with all

the necessary technical equipment, including four LCD televisions, a projector and a control room for translators, so that it can host presentations, projections, round table discussions, seminars and film or literary evenings.

The facility includes a gym spanning 200 square meters, equipped with state-of-the-art equipment from the Italian brand Panatta. The gym is available under preferential conditions to students, academic staff, and employees of the University of Montenegro, while also being accessible to other interested individuals.

Group fitness training services are also offered within the facility.

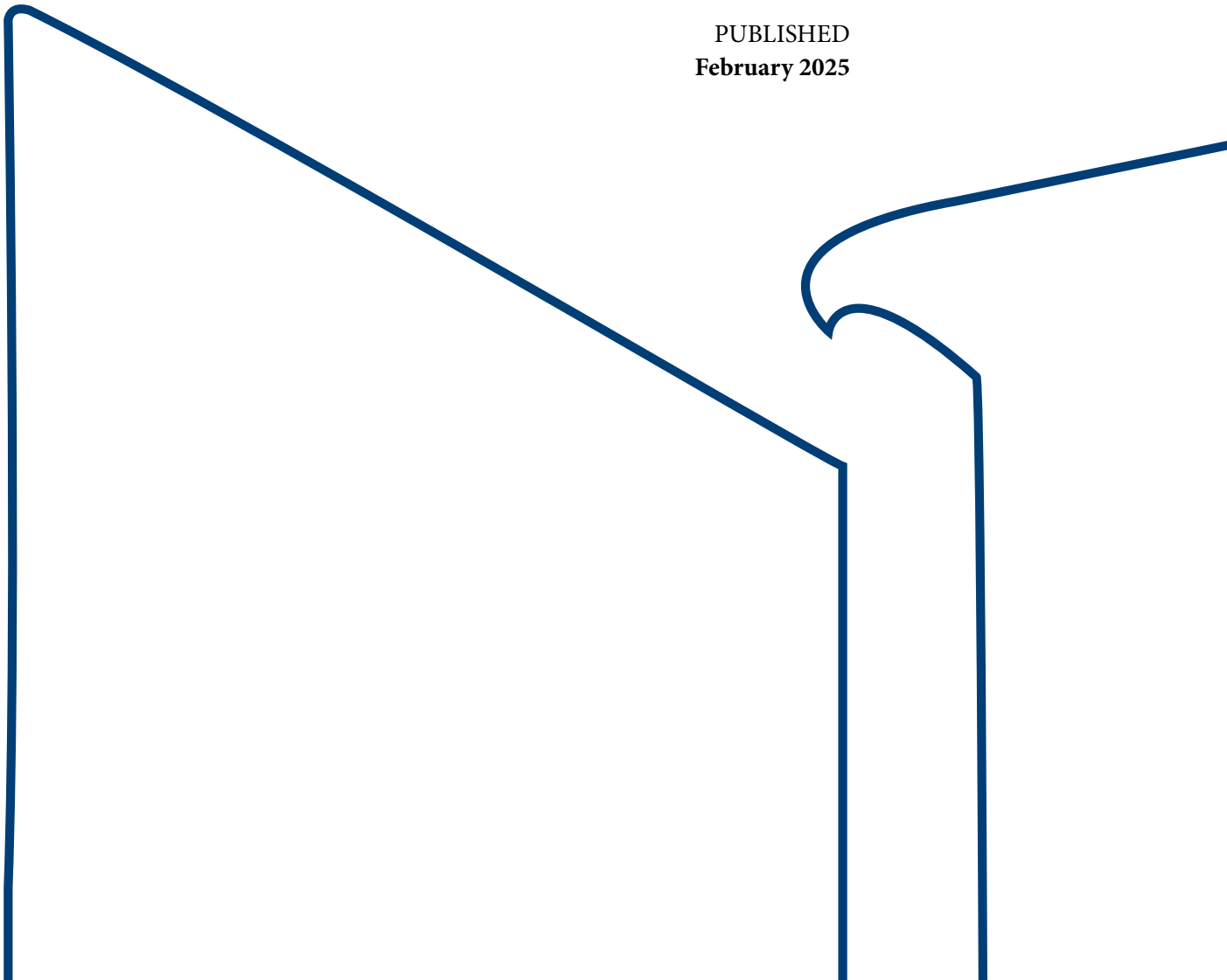
