

Conservation Summer School "Stone Stories"

Location: Trebinje (Ljubomir, Vrpolje), Bosnia and Herzegovina

Date: August 2021

One week Summer School for students and young experts (conservation, architecture, art history, archaeology, history, etc).

Starting with the look at the cultural heritage diversity of the Balkans (focused on territories of Republika Srpska and Serbia).

Investigating the site of the Church of St.Joakim and Ana in Ljubomir and the surrounding Middle Ages necropolis.

Recording and documentation lectures and field work, followed by basic conservation principles and methodology classes in theory and practice.

Additional special tours to the Museum of Trebinje and other sites nearby.

Lecturers and trainers from Serbia and Republika Srpska.

- All applicants will be considered for a scholarship
- **FondAR scholarships** (full and partial) will be available for participants (excluding airfare/travel expenses and **50 EUR** membership for 2021)

NOTE: if the applicant is awarded full scholarship, the amount that he or she is obliged to pay is 50 EUR; if the applicant is awarded partial scholarship, the amount that he or she is obliged to pay is 250 EUR
