The main event of the championship is the International final which will be held in period from **15 to 20 September in Krasnoyarsk (Russia)** the capital of the winter student games 2019. The final will be held in conjunction with the largest International Congress "Non-Ferrous Metals and Minerals 2019" (nfmsib.ru) and more than 10 student teams from different countries will take part in it.

Gathering of teams is at the discretion of the participating countries of the Championship among university students. The number of team members should be from *3 to 10 people* excluding the training coach.

The championship is held with the support of the Presidential Grants Foundation, federal and regional ministries, major industrial companies such as Norilsk Nickel, UC RUSAL, EVRAZ ZSMK, Severstal and others as well as with the support of the best educational institutions of the country!

The key dates of the International final:

- until July 1- accepting applications for participation from universities;

- **until August 1**- sending information about the participants of the Championship (students, mentors, accompanying persons)

- from August 10 to September 1- work on the preparation of the solutions of the case

- until September 10- sending solutions of the case to the organizing committee;

- from September 15 to 20 – holding the Championship final.
