

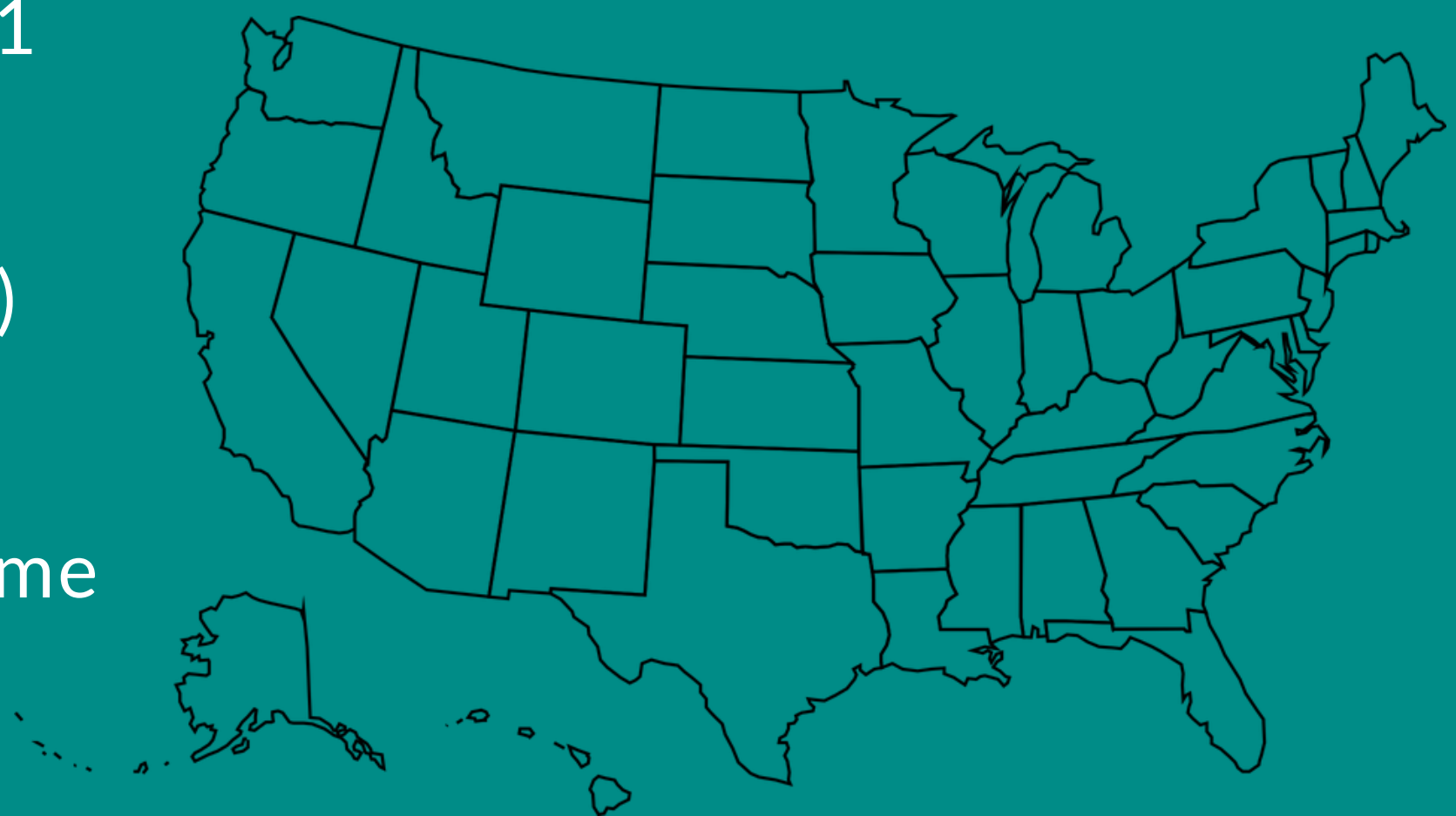
WHAT IS GLOBAL UGRAD?

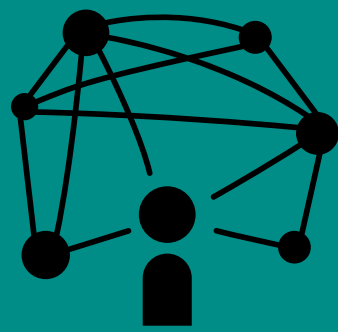
Undergraduate students from all fields of study are encouraged to apply. This program is open to all, regardless of gender, religion, sexual orientation, or disability.

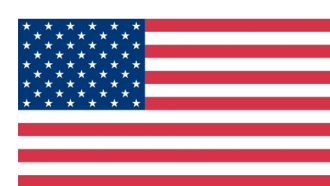
