# BACKGROUND

Summer school (Lifelong Learning) on "Sustainable development of yachting and cruise industry" will be held as a part of the Erasmus+ CBHE project "Fostering Internationalization at Montenegrin HEIs through Efficient Strategic Planning (IESP)", project No. 609675-EPP-1-2019-1-ME-EPPKA2-CBHE-SP.

It is Montenegro's first accredited lifelong learning program, as determined by Decision No. 02-607/22 – 51/74P of the national Agency for Control and Quality Assurance of Higher Education on 21.4.2022.

The summer school will provide students with 2 ECTS and will be conducted in English.

According to the Erasmus+ program guidelines, participants will not be required to pay a tuition fee for the summer school in 2022. Participants must, however, cover their travel and accommodation costs.

The number of participants is limited to a maximum 30.



# LEARNING OUTCOMES

The general learning outcomes are defined by the needs of the market that arose after the research of activities in marinas, cruise ports, maritime agencies, etc. After finalizing IESP summer school, participants will be able to:

- Describe the latest trends in nautical and cruising tourism;
- Apply modern management and marketing methods in marinas and cruise ports;
- Explain modern methods of navigating yachts and cruise ships;
- Describe the concept of infrastructure development of modern marinas and cruise ports;
- Apply modern methods in order to ensure the safety and security of marinas and cruise ports;
- Classify different types of pollutants from yachts and cruise ships and methods of their removal.



# WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Summer school is expected to host a total of 30 participants (students and professionals) from various countries.

Summer school will enable additional education and training of future (students) and current (professionals employed in companies) experts in the field of blue economy by strengthening individual competence and creating a management structure that will better meet the challenges of the future maritime industry development.

It is an interdisciplinary program that includes the wider field of maritime affairs, maritime operations, and their management, nautical and cruising tourism, their impact on the environment, and management of the protection of the marine environment, coast, and others.



# REGISTRATION

There is a separate registration and selection procedure for the IESP Summer School on SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF THE YACHTING AND CRUISE INDUSTRY. Seats are limited and registration is free. You can only participate if you have received (and accepted) the formal invitation from the IESP project, which is due to arrive in early June 2022.

Applications open on May 13th, 2022.

Applications close on June 12th, 2022.
