DEFINITION

What is the Community-Oriented Policing?

THE CENTRAL GOAL

of community policing is for the police to ***build relationships*** with the community through interactions with local agencies and members of the public, creating partnerships and strategies for reducing crime and disorder

ORIGIN

The nine Peelian Principles 1829.

- *central mission* of the police is "to prevent crime and disorder"
- they are an alternative to "repression by military force"

TRADITIONAL POLICING



COMMUNITY POLICING

Reactive

Proactive

Protect law-abiding citizens
from criminals

Assist the public in establishing
and maintaining a safe, orderly
social environment

Identifying and apprehending
criminals while gathering
enough evidence to convict
them

Solving the crimes that the
community is concerned about,
and solving concerns by
working with and gaining
support from the community



Neighbourhood Policing Teams in the United Kingdom

designed to:

- make the police more visible,
- reduce fear
- and aid interaction between the public and the police.



Common Methods of Community-Policing include:

Encouraging
Encouraging the community to help prevent crime by providing advice, giving talks at schools, encouraging neighborhood watch groups, and a variety of other techniques.

Patrols
Increased use of foot or cycle patrols.

Accountability
Increased officer accountability to the communities they are supposed to serve.

Decentralization
Decentralizing the police authority, allowing more discretion amongst lower-ranking officers, and more initiative expected from them.





CONTACT POLICEMAN 02

SPECIALIZED POLICE OFFICER

With their knowledge and skills they should enable direct communication with citizens, gaining insight into the problems of their environment and ,together with them and other subjects of the society, taking measures and actions for their solving.

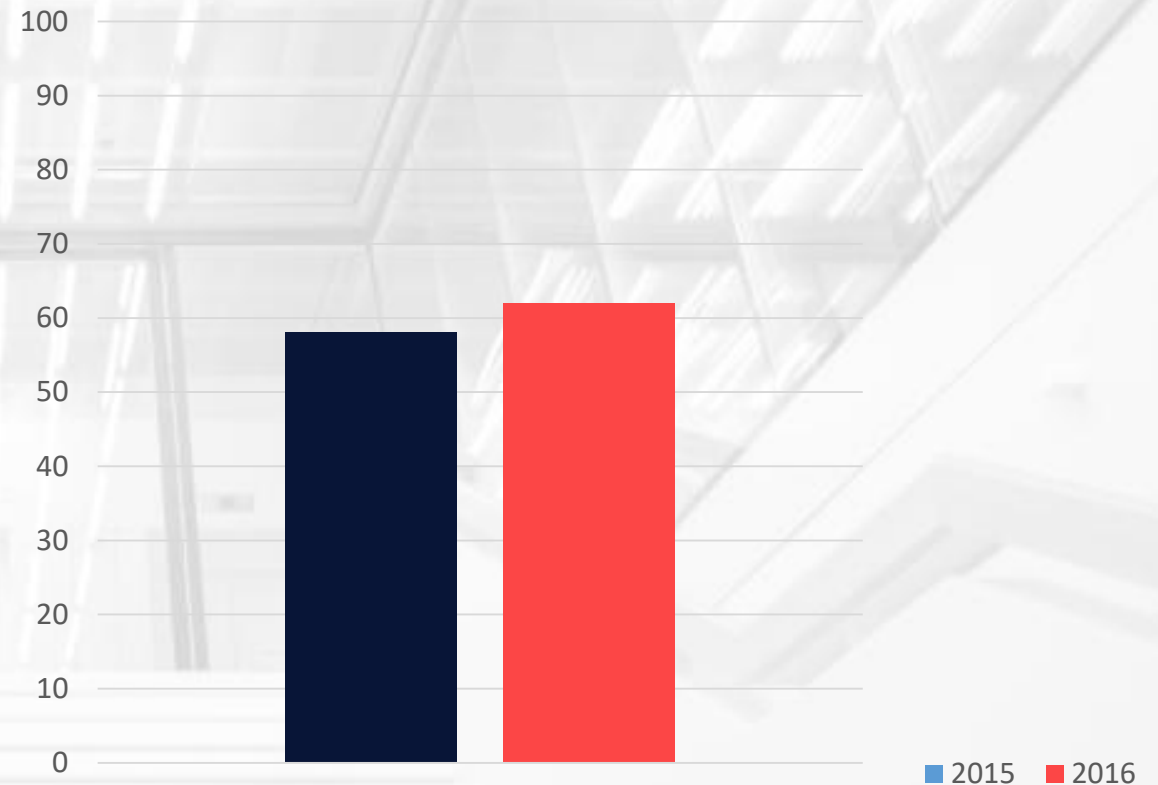
