What is Global UGRAD?

The Global Undergraduate Exchange Program (Global UGRAD Program) is a scholarship program funded by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, U.S. Department of State for emerging undergraduate student leaders from around the world to spend one semester at a U.S. university.

The program is implemented by World Learning.





What is Global UGRAD?

Global UGRAD participants engage in undergraduate, non-degree studies at a diverse U.S. network of accredited institutions.

Participants also engage in local **community service projects** and take part in **cultural enrichment** activities.

Host Institutions



Global UGRAD participants must:

- Be 18+ in age at the time of the program's start.
- Enrolled as a **full-time undergraduate** student in Montenegro.
- · Have familiarity with the English language.
- Have finished at least 1 semester of university before the start of the program.
- Have 1+ semester(s) remaining after the end of the program (or equivalent).







Global UGRAD participants must:

- •Be citizens of the country in which they apply for the Global UGRAD Program.
- •Study in the country in which they apply for the Global UGRAD Program.
- •Be committed to return directly to their home country after the completion of the program.

Preference will be given to those who have had little or NO experience in the U.S. or outside of their home countries.









Which of the following eligibility criteria is incorrect:

- Be at least 18 years old at the time of the program's start;
- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in Montenegro;
- Have completed at least one semester of college by January 2024;
- Have at least one academic year remaining after the end of the program;

Tips

- Do not be afraid to apply! Take time to write your personal statement essay.
- Your English language knowledge and academic success do matter! Be sure to present both well.
- What are your interests? How can you use your U.S. experience upon return to Montenegro?
- Have clear goals in mind (e.g. academic, professional and personal).
- Be honest about your successes and plans. Remember that plagiarism is unforgivable in the U.S. educational system.







Application Essays & Questions

Nailing the essays and making yourself stand out:

DO:

- 1. Answer the question that is being asked;
- 2. Be creative, but answer the question;
- 3. Be professional;
- 4. Be specific, avoid speaking in general terms;
- 5. Show why you want to apply for this program, and not some other;
- 6. Go deep;
- 7. Keep diversity in mind;
- 8. Connect the topic to the school;
- 9. Follow a format;
- 10. Edit Seek feedback Edit.







Application Essays & Questions

Nailing the essays and making yourself stand out:

DO NOT:

- 1. Lie
- 2. Name drop
- 3. Use niche humor
- 4. Be overly controversial
- 5. Use too many big words (be yourself)
- 6. Repeat yourself/ramble
- 7. Go over the suggested length/word count
- 8. Regurgitate your resume
- 9. Make English/grammar errors below your level of English
- 10. Write it in one sitting and submit









What should you do to make your essay stand out?

- Provide a lot of detail about your background and resume
- Be specific about how the program will help you reach your goals
- Explain why you want to visit the United States
- Talk about why Global UGRAD is a cool opportunity
