

He was born in 1954 in Nevesinje (BiH). He finished his primary and secondary school in Mostar. He graduated from the Faculty of Agriculture in Sarajevo, February 29, 1980. on the topic "Production of quality wines Žilavka in the winery Hepok in Mostar" under the mentorship of Dr. Predrag Vuksanović, full professor at the Faculty of Agriculture, University of Sarajevo. He graduated on 07.06.1985. at the Faculty of Agriculture, University of Sarajevo on the topic "Morphological and chemical characteristics of the tree and the peach root during the period of rest", under the mentorship of the regular professor, Dr. Predrag Lučić. At the Faculty of Agriculture, University of Novi Sad, he received his doctorate on February 21, 1992. on the topic "Study of agrobiological and pomological characteristics of actinidia varieties (*Actinidia chinensis* Pl.) in the conditions of Herzegovina", under the mentorship of prof. Dr. Milovan Korać, full professor in fruit growing. It was the first doctoral dissertation in the former SFRY that was engaged in the study of actinidia. He was a scholar of the Tito Fund of the SR BiH.

From 1980 to 1992, he worked at the Research Development Institute in Mostar, and since 1993 he has worked at the University of Montenegro, or at the Biotechnical Faculty in Podgorica.

After agriculture, he also worked on environmental protection activities, where he dealt with the problem of aero pollution, that is, the influence of the emission of fluoride fluids from the Aluminum Combine in Mostar to the plant flora, where he and several associates from the Aluminum Combine published several works.

In the period from 1986 to 1989, he conducted lectures from professional subjects, as an external associate at the Gymnasium "Veljko Vlahović" in Mostar.

He was elected in 1982. to the title of expert associate, 1986 to the title of senior expert associate in 1990 to the position of expert advisor at the Research Development Institute in Mostar, who was a member of the University "Džemal Bijedić" in Mostar.

He was elected to the rank of scientific associate in 1986. in the Research Development Institute of the University "Džemal Bijedić" in Mostar, and in 1995, to the title of senior scientific associate and in 2000 to the title of fruit field scientist at the Biotechnical Institute of the University of Montenegro.

At the Faculty of Agriculture, University of East Sarajevo was elected in 1999. g ., in the title of assistant professor in 2004 to the post of associate professor on the subject of Special fruit growing. At the Agromediterranean Faculty of the University "Džemal Bijedić" in Mostar, was elected in 2013. to the title of full professor from the narrow scientific field "fruit growing".

He is employed for an indefinite period at the Biotechnical Faculty in Podgorica at the Basic Academic Study Program "Herbal Production", postgraduate specialist study "Fruit and Vineyard" and postgraduate master's degree "Fruit-growing - Viticulture - Wine".

He also works on the applied program "Mediterranean fruit growing" and at the specialist study "Nursing" in Bar.

He teaches the following subjects: General fruit growing, Special fruit growing, Nursery production, Contemporary breeding forms in fruit growing, Agropomotechnics, Horticulture and Practical classes.

From 2009 to 2016, he was the Head of the Center for Subtropical Cultures in Bar and the Applied Study Program "Mediterranean Fruit" and the specialist study "Nursing" in Bar.

In 1997, he was elected FRY expert in fruit growing, nursery, ecology, selection and agropomotechnology.

He worked as a visiting professor from 1999 to 2008 at the Faculty of Agriculture in East Sarajevo, and from 2005 to 2013 he was engaged at the Agromediterranean Faculty of the University, Džemal Bijedić in Mostar.

From 1986 to 1992 he was a court expert at the Basic and Higher Court in Mostar, and in 2005 he was appointed as a permanent expert witness in the area of agriculture in Montenegro. He is a member of the Court of Honor of the Association of Court Experts of Montenegro.

He holds a license from the Employment Service (ZZZCG) since 1999 for the development and evaluation of business plans and loan grants to stimulate employment and entrepreneurship, where he has developed 130 business programs.

He was a mentor in the preparation of 20 diploma papers and 115 specialist papers and more than 40 times a member of the commission for evaluation and defense of specialist work as a member and / or commission president.

He was also a mentor and member of the commission for evaluation and defense of 12 master theses and 5 times a member of the commission for evaluation and defense of the master's thesis in the capacity of a member and / or the president of the commission.

The mentor is one doctoral dissertation and three times a member of the commission for evaluation and defense of the doctoral dissertation as a member of the commission.

The author and co - author of 17 projects and programs for raising orchards and nurseries and manager or associate in 34 scientific - research projects, international, national and bilateral.

She is the author of the book *Aktinidija-Kiwi* (UDK 634,7), which was published in 5 editions (1989, 1990, 1994, 2000, 2011); coauthor of the monograph "Formation of the bank of fruits gene SFRJ", (1992): Faculty of Agriculture, Cacak, University of Kragujevac, coauthor of the book "Fruit-growing"(1994,2001): UDK 634.1, Agricultural News Library, Fruit and Vegetable Community, pg.512, Belgrade, coauthor of the book, *Plantation growing and processing of buckwheat, lavender and rosemary in the subtropical zone of Montenegro*(1995), Institute for subtropical crops Bar and Export bilje, Risan, coauthor of the book *Plantation Systematics*, 2012, Agromediterranean Faculty of the University "Džemal Bijedić", Mostar.

Author and co-author of 9 reviews, 115 scientific papers and abstracts and 15 expert papers.

He was 19 times in the capacity of a commission member or commission president to write a report for the selection of scientific titles and 6 times for the selection of teaching and associate titles. The recess is 4 textbooks and 4 books.

He is a participant in a number of congresses, symposiums, consultations, workshops and conferences in the country and abroad, and was in Italy specializing in several foreign trips abroad (Italy, USSR, Hungary, Greece).

He is a member of the Faculty of Science and Technology of the University of Montenegro and a member of the school board of the JU Secondary Vocational School in Bar.
