

Invitation to an energy workshop at Reykjavik University

In the frame of the Erasmus K71 project between Reykjavik University and Montenegro University (Project period 2023-2026) RU would like to invite staff from the University of Montenegro to visit RU and participate in a workshop on sustainable energy development. Faculty members from civil engineering, mechanical engineering, forestry, and architecture are invited to apply for a fully funded Erasmus+ grant to visit RU in Iceland.

- 1) Sustainable hydropower in Montenegro
- 2) Ocean current energy and Marine issues
- 3) Renewable energy development
- 4) Bioenergy sources

Participants are expected to prepare a short presentation on one of the topics above. The objective to the workshop is to identify topics for future student exchanges between the University of Montenegro and RU.
