Selection Process

The applications are evaluated according to the fair and transparent selection procedure. Therefore, candidates are selected in a transparent manner according to the publicly published criteria. Students and staff apply to their respective faculties, which make the list of candidates and submit it to the International Relations Office at the university level. The International Relations Office makes the final list of nominated students to be sent to partner universities. Staff candidates employed at the Rectorate apply directly to the IRO, where the Committee for Selection of Candidates Participating in the Mobility makes the final selection.

According to Article II of the Decision on the criteria for selection of students in mobility programmes, students with a physical or psychosocial disability, severe and chronic conditions/diseases, an unfavorable socio-economic status, a student from a rural area, a member of the Romani population and a student who has a child advantage in mobility program competitions.
