Selection Process

Applications are evaluated through a fair and transparent selection process, guided by the *Decision on the Criteria for Selection of Students in Mobility Programmes*. Candidates are therefore selected in an open and transparent manner according to publicly available criteria. Students apply through their respective faculties, which compile candidate lists and forward them to the university's International Relations and Mobility Office (IRMO). After the university's International Relations and Mobility Office publishes the final list of selected candidates, students have the right to submit an appeal within the designated period. Once this period expires, the final list of nominated students is sent to the partner university via a nomination email.

Appeal procedure: An email with a clearly stated reason and detailed explanation of the appeal regarding the selection results should be sent to the Vice Dean for International Cooperation or the Vice Dean responsible for international cooperation, as well as to the Office for International Cooperation and Mobility. (It is required to send one email with both addresses included.) The student has the right to submit an appeal within two working days after the results are published. Appeals submitted after this period will not be considered.
