- The conference is open to undergraduate and graduate students of any higher education institution;
- The applicant must **register** through the e-application. See the registration link: <https://bit.ly/3M6SrmL>
- The collection of papers of the conference participants and the e-copy of the certificate of participation in the conference will be sent to all participants after the end of the conference; (An article will be published in the Proceedings of the Conference, which will be approved by the members of the Conference Scientific Board and will meet the requirements set by the Conference for the paper).
- The participant will be given 8-10 minutes for the presentation of the work, 5 minutes for debates;
- Abstract and full paper should be submitted at the following e-mail address: studconference@bntu.edu.ge ;
- The conference will be held using the online platform „Zoom “.
- All participants will be sent a link to the conference 1 day before the start of the conference;
- Participation in the conference is free.
- The Scientific Council is authorized not to allow an applicant with incomplete documentation or the author of an incorrectly translated abstract;
- Confirmation of participation in the conference will be emailed to the applicant. The author of the abstract admitted to the conference must submit the full text of the paper after the approval of the Scientific Council;
- The paper can have more than one author (maximum three);

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES AND ABSTRACTS

Requirements for Abstract

- Abstract should be min. 150 – max.300 words;
- The abstract should be done in two languages: Georgian (for Georgian Participants) and English;
- The paper must have at least 4 keywords;
- Keywords should be presented in Georgian (for Georgian Participants) and English;
- Use the **template** when submitting the abstract (will be provided to registered applicants).

Requirements for Article

- Student scientific papers are accepted in Georgian or English languages;
- The paper includes an abstract in Georgian (for Georgian Participants) and English;
- Article should be min. 4 and max. 10 pages;

The structure of the paper should include the following parts:

- Introduction, which includes the relevance of the paper;
- The main part, which includes the research methodology and the obtained results;
- Final part, which includes findings, possible recommendations and future perspectives;
- The name and surname of the author (s) of the paper should be indicated in Georgian and English languages (for Georgian participants), and in case of foreign participants in English;
- Information about the supervisor of the paper, if any, must be submitted with the paper;
- Bibliography (list of used literature) must be submitted together with the paper;
- The paper must be designed in accordance with the Chicago-Academic style;

The abstract and paper should be submitted with the following parameters:

- Font for Georgian version - Sylfaen; for English version - TimesNewRoman;
- 14 Bold; Font size: Titles (Title of the paper, applicant's name and surname, name of higher educational institution and learning level (Bachelor; Master), supervisor's name and surname, academic degree and position) - 14 Bold;
- 12; Font size for the main part of the paper - 12;
- Line spacing - 1,5;
- Page Marings- 2,5 (top, bottom, left, right);
- Citation should be done in Chicago academic style. *For more information on Chicago Academic Style, see the following link: <https://cutt.ly/3c4BALx>*
- Use the **template** prepared by Batumi Navigation Teaching University (will be provided to registered applicants) to complete the paper.
