| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Distinguish the basics of the hierarchy on board and the responsibilities of the ship's crew members. - Identifying specific situations as dangerous on board (e.g. stress, alcohol, workload, different authorities, etc.) and analysing the characteristics of seafarers (attitude, effort, assertiveness, positive initiative). - Describe the leadership, teamwork and planning activities and exercises on board. - Define the elements of good or weak organizational structure on the ship. - Analyse the cultural differences of multinational crews, and accordingly, the optimal organization of the crew. | | |
