

Pursuant to Article 6, paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Rules on International Student Mobility (UCG Bulletin no. 443/18), the Rector of the University of Montenegro hereby issues the following

DECISION
on establishing criteria for the selection of students in mobility programs

1. Ranking of students for mobility programs is done based on the following criteria:
 - a) Academic Performance - up to 4 points (average grade is multiplied by 0.4);
 - b) Motivational letter - up to 2 points, as follows:
 - Motivational letter directed towards the host university and field of study (2 points),
 - Weaker, more abstract, less original motivational letter (1 point),
 - Non-original motivational letter or one copied from another author (0 points);
 - c) Documented extracurricular activities (participation in international student events, involvement in student organizations, participation in humanitarian work, professional development, attending summer schools, volunteer work, etc.) - up to 2 points, as follows:
 - participation in volunteer work, especially in connection with events of international nature organized by UCG and humanitarian work – 1 point,
 - participation in the Erasmus Student Network (ESN) (1 point),
 - other extracurricular activities (0.5 points),
 - No activities (0 points);
 - d) Language proficiency - up to 1 point, as follows:
 - Proof of proficiency in English at level C1 or C2 (0.5 points),
 - Proof of proficiency in the language of instruction (if not English) at a minimum of level B2 (0.5 points);
 - e) Participation in mobility programs during the same study cycle - up to 1 point, as follows:
 - No participation in mobility programs (1 point),
 - For one participation in mobility programs (0.5 points),
 - For two or more participations in mobility programs (0 points).
2. A student with a physical or psychosocial disability, severe and chronic conditions/diseases, disadvantaged socio-economic status, a student from rural areas, a member of the RAE (Roma, Ashkali, and Egyptian) population, and a student who has a child has priority in the mobility program competitions.

3. This decision shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the UCG Bulletin.
4. With the entry into force of this decision, the Decision on the Criteria for the Selection of Students in Mobility Programs, No. 01-4227 dated December 27, 2018, shall cease to apply.
