

Workshop: Why was my paper rejected?

In this seminar, Dr. David Peralta, Editor-in-Chief of ChemMedChem (A Chemistry Europe journal), opens up the black box of publishing. David earned his B.S. and Master's degree in Chemistry at the Ateneo de Manila University, Philippines. In 2009, he moved to Heidelberg for his Ph.D. at the German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ) and University of Heidelberg. Shortly after his Ph.D., he worked as an Assistant Editor at Wiley-VCH in Germany for the journals *ChemistryOpen*, *ChemistrySelect*, and *ChemMedChem*. He has been the Editor-in-Chief of *ChemMedChem* since 2017. Aside from doing his editorial tasks for the Wiley-VCH journals, he has also given numerous workshops internationally on all topics related to scientific publishing and communication.
