The Integrated Learning for Peace project is financed through the Erasmus+ Key Action2: Cooperation for Innovation and Exchange of Good Practices, Cooperation Partnership in the field of Youth. The aim of the project is to create innovative tools for youth and educators in the filed of peacebuildimng, through: Creation of a common framework of key competencies in the sectors of formal and informal education, Supporting young people to find the necessary but also flexible ways to access relevant learning opportunities, Integrating formal and informal learning approaches for more comprehensive service provision, using modern technologies.
